Message from our Pastor:

HAPPY BIRTHDAY!!!! TODAY IS OUR BIRTHDAY!!!

Pentecost is the Catholic Church's birthday. Enjoy some cake and ice cream today!!!

That's right. Today the Holy Spirit came down on the scaredy-cat apostles and turned them into warriors for God ready to even be martyred. That's what the Holy Spirit does when it gets in us...it transforms us into to super-zealots for God. Without it, the Church would be d-e-a-d.

So many things that we enjoy in the Church are only made possible by the 'work' of the Holy Spirit. All the Sacraments come to us by way of the Holy Spirit. The Church's teaching office is guided and protected from error by the Holy Spirit. Saints are inspired by the Holy Spirit. Fr Rossi gets out of bed when he otherwise would just lay there...you guessed it...because of the Holy Spirit!

We cannot underestimate the gift we receive in what the Holy Spirit gives us. And Pentecost is the unleashing of that Spirit. It's an awesome, awesome, awesome event.

There are also many spiritual consolations and gifts that come to us through the Holy Spirit. If and when you feel God's presence (which is the best feeling in the world), it is the Holy Spirit that makes that happen. When we are sad

We may sometimes not feel comfortable when we are not sure of something, as to whether it is from the Holy Spirit or not, and it is always good to be a little cautious, but we should NEVER be so scared of what is new or out of our comfort zone that we block it off altogether...otherwise we could be resisting the very Spirit of God, the Holy Spirit...GOD!

After all, your pastor would NOT be saying Mass today or hearing confessions had the Holy Spirit not hit him over the head in a very 'charismatic' experience...I'd probably be an accountant, working to better myself solely, and running from the priesthood like a bad dream.

So next time you feel the Holy Spirit nudging you to do something you know is good and right, although maybe a little uncomfortable, just throw your hands up in the air and jump in. I promise the Holy Spirit will take care of the rest.
