### Message from our Pastor:

"Say to those whose hearts are frightened: Be strong, fear not!" - First reading

One of my favorite images from our history of the Church is a little girl looking up at her soon to be executioner and smiling.

St Agnes was 13 years old and was beheaded because she stood strong for her Christian faith. But what is so amazing about her is that the accounts of her death say that as she had her head on the chopping block, literally, the executioner standing there was the one who had fear in his heart, NOT the little girl who was to be beheaded. He could not understand how she had such strength...he was afraid of her fortitude.

Can you imagine being a 13 year old girl and striking fear into the heart of your executioner?!?!!!!

Faith gives you power. Faith gives you strength. Faith drives away fear. When you have faith, nothing can take away the thing you ultimately live for, heaven. When you have faith, even your own life (your human, earthly life) can be given away, forcibly or voluntarily, because ultimately it simply serves as means to your eternal reward.
