Message from our Pastor:

I like building things. It is my hobby. I have built room additions and remodeled bathrooms and kitchens for people I know and at the rectory where I live. I love making things look nice that were once run down and dated.

In doing this I have learned that you need good straight boards to build with. If you buy boards that have a curve in them, it makes everything else difficult. For example, if you frame a wall with a curved 2x4, the drywall won't sit nice, you'll see a bow in the wall, the baseboard and trim won't sit flat, etc. When the thing on the inside is messed up, it makes everything else on top of the project harder and becomes messed up as well.

Jesus is the stone rejected by the builders that has become the corner stone as heard in the first reading and responsorial psalm. The corner stone is the thing on which the whole building depends. If it were bad or faulty, like a crooked 2x4, everything else done after that would be difficult to install and messed up.

Here is why they made such a bad mistake back then, and why people still make really bad mistakes now when they don't build on Jesus in their life.

They rejected Jesus then, and people reject Jesus now because they think he is a bad stone, a curved 2x4, so they throw Him in the scrap pile.

But this is the worst mistake people can make. In fact, Jesus is the most perfect stone to be used to support the whole structure. There is no stone stronger or more perfectly fit for the spot. He is the most perfect 2x4, not just a pine board but made of something even stronger than mahogany and precisely shaped. He is the perfect cornerstone, the perfect support for a wall. If you build on Him, everything else you build on top of Him will be easier and come out better in the end, just like if you build a wall with straight 2x4's. It will be a whole lot easier to hang the drywall and install the trim.

Our lives are easier and come out a whole lot better when we build on Jesus. There are a whole lot of other things we can be tempted to build our lives on, but they are flimsy, crooked, curved and inferior.

Build on Jesus, and you will have a wonderful building. You will have a great life and things will work out well in the end. -Fr Rossi
