## Message from Father Maxwell:

The church by nature is missionary by preaching the Gospel as witnesses of Christ to everyone, as mandated by Jesus to his disciples: "**Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you**"....(Mt. 28:19ff).
