## Message from the Administrator's Desk:

Today, Christians throughout the world are celebrating Easter Sunday, the resurrection event of Jesus as the most factual recorded singular event in the world that has shaped human history so much that it is very well elaborated in the New Testament (Lk.24, Mt. 28: 1-15, Mk. 16:1-14, Jn. 20:1-29), to prove the power of God beyond all measures.

Without the crucifixion, there wouldn't have been any resurrection; they are both a *historical* event and a *faith* event. Jesus rose triumphantly from the dead on the third day after His Crucifixion and by that has unlocked for us the path to eternity. May the resurrected Christ reign in the hearts and in the homes of all families, so that where there is division and confusion, unity is sowed, and where there is darkness the light of Christ shines.

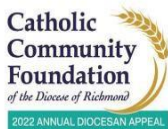
