Message from the Administrator's Desk:

Dear Parishioners,

A *Parish/Parochial Administrator* is a canonical term given to a suitable priest chosen by the diocesan bishop to temporarily replace a pastor in a parish to fulfill its pastoral care (can. 524, 539), and to assume the same rights and duties of a Pastor (can. 540) for a **temporary period** of time determined by the bishop. That is how last year July, I became the Parish Administrator of the Cluster Churches of St. John, St. Peter and St. Patrick.

Recently, I received a letter from the bishop appointing me to be the *Pastor* (can. 526) of these 3 Cluster churches effective *July 1, 2022* for a **permanent period**, entrusting me with the pastoral care (can. 515,1) of this community of Christian faithful. By this the bishop has given me the functions of *Teaching* (Catechetical formation and Evangelical outreach, can. 528,1); *Sanctifying* (by having prayerful sacramental celebrations of baptizing new members, reconciling penitents, anointing the sick, assisting at weddings and funerals etc., can. 528,2) as well as governing (pastoral administration, can. 532), all under the authority of the bishop.

The title Pastor therefore comes from the Latin word *pascere* meaning shepherd, to pasture, to lead etc. He is assisted by other priest(s) or Deacon(s) (if any), and Lay persons carrying out ministerial roles in the parish community (can. 519).

On this note, whilst thanking you all for your cooperation so far, I would like to ask for more cooperation and collaboration especially with Volunteers in the various ministries. It is my fervent prayer that the Spirit of the Lord as it descended on the Apostles on Pentecost, will continue to guide us all to do the Lord's will always, for the sanctification of all the souls in our parishes.
