Message from the Pastor's Desk:

Dear Parishioners,

As I celebrate my Silver Jubilee (25 years) in the priestly ministry on Tuesday 19th July, I would like to share with you how I was inspired and responded to the call of the Lord to work in his vineyard, and how it unfolded.

I remember at a tender age of 10 yrs, one day I was having dinner with my Father and siblings (6) when he asked each of us our future carrier. When it came to my turn, I just said: "I will become a priest." he then said to me "don't you want to become a Doctor or Engineer or a Pharmacist or a Lawyer," and I replied, "even if I become any of those, I will still become a priest." Since then I discerned to achieve my aim, by entering the seminary for philosophical studies13 years after completing college. Then I had the theological studies at a Pontifical University in Rome, where I obtained a Bachelor's Degree in Sacred Theology. Returning to my diocese (Obuasi in Ghana), I was ordained a priest by the bishop in 1997 at the age of 30 yrs. Five years later, I was sent to Rome again to pursue a specialization in Moral Theology in the same University, after which on coming back, I lectured in one of the Provincial Seminaries home for 7years.

In my 25yrs as a priest, I have ministered in various capacities in my diocese as Vocations Promoter, Chaplain for the youth, Pastor in 3 different parishes, Parochial Vicar and Rector of the Cathedral, and finally Vicar General (assisting the Bishop) & Moderator of the Diocesan Curia. With all these experiences at home, I requested for an exposure in the Pastoral ministry in a different environment outside my diocese for some time, which was granted by my bishop to send me as "fidei donum" to the Richmond diocese, and now I find myself as the Pastor for this Cluster of churches. I am grateful to you all for accepting me and celebrating with me this memorable Milestone in my life. God richly bless you.

Looking at how far the Lord has brought me, 25 years in his Vineyard, what shall I say unto Him? all I have to say is "Thank you Lord," as I lift up the cup of salvation and call on His powerful name. (Ps. 116:13).

Obedience, Humility and Self-sacrifice have ever been my watch words in the ministry. The happiest moment in my priesthood is when my mother converted from the Episcopal Church to the Catholic Church and remained an active catholic till she was called to eternity 13 years ago.

May her gentle soul rest in perfect peace. -Father Maxwell
