# Message from the Pastor's Desk:

Human life is always a precious gift from God and its sanctity from conception to natural death is to be respected and defended all the time, since it comes from God as his image and imprint. God is therefore the sole Lord of this life because the body belongs to Him (1 Cor.6:19ff), and as such, man cannot do with his life as he wills or dispose of at will (Cf. Pope John Paul II, Evangelium Vitae, n. 39). Any attempt to do so is opposing God's love for the human person and violating the fundamental rights of the Human person. This explains why march for life is more about loving God and sharing the Gospel message to love one another (Jn. 13:34)), so as to protect the sanctity of life.

The Baby Bottle campaign is thus a means of raising funds in protecting life and loving families. As of now, out of the bottles picked up during Lent, St. Peter Pro-Cathedral has donated \$1,075.33, whilst St. Patrick church donated \$1,583.82 and St. John church contributed \$2,310.18 respectively.
