## Message from the Pastor's Desk:

Dear Parishioners,
Coming Monday is the Solemnity of The
Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is a
dogma of faith proclaimed by Pope Pius XII in the
Year 1950 stating: "the immaculate mother of
God, the ever-virgin Mary, having completed the
course of her earthly life, was assumed body and
soul into heavenly glory." Since then, it has been
an important feast on the liturgical calendar
observed as a Holyday of Obligation celebrated
every 15<sup>th</sup> of August each year. Joyfully, some do
that with the procession of the Marian Statue
asking for heavenly favors through her
intercession.

Among the reasons why the Marian Assumption is celebrated is as follows:

- Mary's close association with all mysteries of Jesus's life, as well as sharing fully in his glorification.
- Jesus's Ascension to the Father in heaven opens the way for Mary to be taken up (Assumption) into heaven to join her son (Rev. 11:19; 12:1ff), this is the woman escorted by an army of heavenly holy angels.
- She is in heaven (a place for the Holy ones) because of her sinlessness, since she was full of grace (Lk. 1:28)
- Jesus' words of going to prepare a place in his Father's house for his loved ones, and coming back to take them with him (Jn. 14:1-4), comes true for Mary as

her mother and his first apostle at the wedding at Cana (Jn. 2:3ff)

- She is the lowly handmaid who deeply reverenced her God (Lk. 1"46ff) and has been raised to the heights.
- She is one of the first fruits who had fallen asleep (1 Cor. 15:20) but has been raised and dwells in heaven.

Let us celebrate the Assumption feast with joy in the masses at St. Peter (12.05pm), St. Patrick (6.00pm), St. John (7pm) and ask the blessed mother to intercede for us and our families.
