## Christmas Message from the Pastor

Today, the whole world celebrates Christmas, the word of God made flesh and dwelt among men, which we see his glory as the son of the Father (cf. Jn. 1:14). The shepherds (ordinary people) were the first to see the child Jesus in the manger with Mary and Joseph (Lk. 2:16) at Bethlehem, which in Hebrew (Beit Lehem) means House of Bread, and the shepherds saw Jesus, (the bread from heaven as proclaimed by Jesus himself sometime in his ministry when he said; "I am the bread of life that came down from heaven..." Jn. 6:51), lying in the manger covered with swaddling clothes.
