

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Ones,

Forty days after Easter Sunday is the celebration of the **Ascension of the Lord**, the mystery of the ending of Jesus' visible presence among his followers, the disciples, observed every year by the church in many Dioceses in the US on the Seventh Sunday of Easter instead. (Cf. The General Norms of the Liturgical Year, No. 25).

It is simply the exaltation of Christ Jesus at the right hand of the Father, after completing his work here on earth and was taken up in a cloud (Acts.1:9), as the two men dressed in white beside him declared: "this same Jesus who has been taken from you into heaven will come back the same way..." (Acts.

1:11). This clearly indicates the close association between the Ascension and the second coming of the Lord. Interestingly, what appeared as Jesus' departure, really prefigures his return in glory as professed in the Creed every Sunday.

The Ascension of Jesus indeed is an indication to us his followers that we will never labor or toil in vain, but will receive an everlasting reward one day from the Father in heaven. May he give us the strength to withstand all challenges we are faced with in every life situation.
