

Message from Our Pastor

Who doesn't empathize with the words of the youthful prophet, Jeremiah in his lamentation in the first reading this week?

You duped me, O Lord, and I let myself be duped...All the day I am an object of laughter...the word of the Lord has brought me derision and reproach all the day. I say to myself, I will not mention him...

Sometimes, being a Christian is not easy, at home, in the workplace, or on the street.. A significant challenge for all of us is to "discern" what is coming from us and what is coming from the Lord. To "discern" is to "sift," to weigh options and ideas against one another to determine the right course, the good action. While Jeremiah knows he must speak the Lord's message, he tries not to because it brings pain and separation, but because he is sifting out the emotions from the call of the Lord, he is able to recognize that the Word given to him is "like fire burning in my heart, imprisoned in my bones," it must be spoken. He sees the difference between his way and the Lord's way and begins to speak.

When you look at your life and make decisions, what is coming from you and what is coming from the Lord? How do you know the difference, or more simply, are you even looking? I know in my own life, sometimes I'm just trying to get through the day and make it

to the next day, but when I am actively looking for how He is working the day is much more interesting, active, and peaceful.

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a journey for Welcoming Adult newcomers (inquires) into the Roman Catholic Church. RCIA is for adults who, after having their hearts opened to conversion and faith by the Holy Spirit, seek to become fully initiated members of the Catholic Church. The RCIA process assists them in becoming full, conscious, active, and ongoing participants in a life with Christ and His Church. RCIA welcomes those who are not baptized, those who are baptized in another Christian tradition and those who are baptized Catholic but never received the Sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation. An RCIA class will be starting at SPC on September 10th. Anyone interested is welcome to join the class.
