In the first reading, we see the Lord's promise to send His Son, seen through the image of King's David's desire to construct a Temple. Historically, the first temple will be built by his son, Solomon, and it will be fully realized in the Incarnation. As we turn from the penitence of Advent to the glorious simplicity of the Nativity, how are you handing your desires over to the Lord so that He might properly purify them and fulfill them.

Practically, as we start the Christmas season this evening, try to be intentional about calling a desire to mind and spiritually hand it to the Lord asking him to purify it and heal it for you. Add to it an intention to be very deliberate in your engagement with others over the Christmas season. The Father deliberately sent His Son, so that His gaze might heal us. You and I share in that in the ways that we are deliberate with one another.
