## Message from Our Pastor

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family. It was established by Pope Benedict XV in 1921 and was originally set within the context of the Octave (8-day celebration) of the Feast of the Epiphany (the Sunday between January 7 and 13). With the revision of the liturgical rites, it was transferred to the Sunday after the Feast of the Nativity (Christmas). It was first celebrated in 1841 as a local feast of the Diocese of Quebec.

For Catholics, the family is the first experience of faith. As we hear from St. Paul, "faith comes through hearing" (Romans 10:17). Your decision to share the faith through signs and symbols is essential for our youth to grow in "wisdom and grace" as we hear in the Gospel of Matthew. Our youth will come to understand the necessity of the sacraments because of your worthy and deliberate celebration of the same. I came to see the necessity of confession, because I watched my father make a deliberate attempt to access the sacrament regularly. When he recognized he wasn't prepared to go to Communion, he didn't jump in line, and neither did my siblings and I. He demonstrated faith by actively participating in Church and demanding that the culture of the home was imbued with religious ritual.

Consider setting up a home altar, with icons, crosses, liturgical colors, et cetera, to show your family members the centrality of the faith at home where Christ can be the King of hearts.
