PASTOR'S WEEKLY REFLECTION

Watch carefully how you live...

This weeks readings are rather practical. What are your pattens of behavior, what do you know needs to be adjusted. St. Francis de Sales has some practical advice: plan it out. In his recommendations for developing one's spiritual life, he suggests that we should plan the night before what we will reflect upon the next morning, so as not to waste time wandering around the scriptures or other texts looking for something to reflect upon. We can use the same advice for looking at our vices and random guilty pleasures. We don't work on them because the Lord doesn't want us to have joy, we work on them because we know that some of our patterns of behavior are not brining true joy, or evangelizing our friends and family. Take some time to list out what you need to reform and how you might make some practical changes. Please be assured of my prayers this week. Fr. Capuano
