## COMMUNITY NOTE

As those who assist at **The Pro-Cathedral of Saint Peter** in the various social ministries know, the last couple of months have seen an increase in a new crowd of folks needing assistance and a place to stay. We have seen upwards of 30 tents a night put up in the parking lot, resulting in overwhelming health and safety concerns, as well as ministries not associated with the parish distributing food and other goods. I have been working with the Richmond Police to develop a system to protect the property and ensure that ministries belonging to Saint Peter can function. **Moving forward, no one is permitted to loiter on the property, unless they have a legitimate need to be at Saint Peter for worship or an event initiated by our community. The police can and will be called to invite individuals to move on from the property or risk being arrested for trespassing. At this point, the message seems to have been received.** In the coming weeks, I hope to continue conversations with outside groups to find new ways to assist those in need, within the scope of parish abilities, recognizing we still need to be the face of mercy for those who need assistance. - Fr. Capuano

## MUSIC AT SAINT PATRICK &amp; SAINT JOHN

The entrance antiphon in the Missal "opens the celebration [of Mass] and introduced the thoughts of the mystery of the liturgical time" (GIRM). We know it is listed as something that we should be doing in the Missal instructions, but! How do we go about singing the entrance antiphon? This is a bit more complicated and requires a few more musical decisions, since there is no musical notation in the Missal for the antiphon. There are a few ways to go about it. The first option that the *General Instruction* gives is to sing the musical setting in the book, the *Graduale Romanum*, which has latin text and square-note (not modern) musical notation. The second option the *General Instruction* gives is to sing from the *Graduale Simplex*. The entrance antiphon in this book is also in latin and in square-note notation, but the melody is simpler to sing. The third option is to sing "another chant that is suited to the sacred action." Sometimes I compose the melody for the entrance antiphon, and sometimes the cantor will sing from a collection of melodies written by a Benedictine monk, Samuel Weber, OSB. - Virginia Tilley

The bishop was ordained a priest in Rome in 1870, his first assignment was at St. Peter, he later became bishop of the diocese in 1889.
