> **Restoration and renewal in the Church:** As you know, we recently restored three statues and pedestals that were in storage. The Sacred Heart statue had lost its feet and pedestal and one of the hands (according the restorers, the statue dates to before or around 1900). The other two statues are unique in their own right and date to the early 1900s, both saints depicted are patrons of the missions, St. Francis Xavier, from the Society of Jesus and St. Thérèse de Lisieux, from the discalced Carmelites, her statue is of Spanish origin.

> Currently the company has taken the Mary and Joseph statues for restoration. We welcome contributions that will help preserve these works of art for a new generation. Please contact the office if you would like to make a memorial to continue to preserve elements of this unique Church in the

> Additionally, we're continuing to address the need of restoring and repairing various marble features in the Church, I hope to meet with a local contractor in the coming weeks. We welcome designated donations for this project as well.

> Lastly, we do have some plaster issues and hope to be able to address possible leaks in the roof in the near future.
