Saint Peter continues assisting the Department of Social Services, helping those financially, spiritually, and physically.

Social Ministry: I'm grateful for hard work of parishioners and non-parishioners who have found a home in our social ministry efforts at St. Peter. We're continuing efforts to maintain and expand our offerings, while striving to also protect our property and ensure that it is safe and welcoming for those coming to worship and receive social aid. I'm grateful also for the collaboration that is developing with opportunities at each of the parishes this fall. What do you local faith leaders and our developing relationship with the dedicated officers of the 1st Precinct of the City Police. - Fr. Capuano

> **Formation:** We're starting up a formation session to assist the non-baptized, Catholics who need to receive sacraments, and those Catholics who need a refresher. Presently, we are working on developing the schedule. The sessions will be held on periodic Sundays after the 8:30 AM Mass. The first meeting will be Sunday, October 6th in the parlor (to the left of the front doors of the Church). For more information, please contact Fr. Capuano.

> **Restoration and renewal in the Church:** As you know, we recently restored three statues and pedestals that were in storage. The Sacred Heart statue had lost its feet and pedestal and one of the hands (according the restorers, the statue dates to before or around 1900). The other two statues are unique in their own right and date to the early 1900s, both saints depicted are patrons of the missions, St. Francis Xavier, from the Society of Jesus and St. Thérèse de Lisieux, from the discalced Carmelites, her statue is of Spanish origin.

> Currently the company has taken the Mary and Joseph statues for restoration. We welcome contributions that will help preserve these works of art for a new generation. Please contact the office if you would like to make a memorial to continue to preserve elements of this unique Church in the City.

> Additionally, we're continuing to address the need of restoring and repairing various marble features in the Church, I hope to meet with a local contractor in the coming weeks. We welcome designated donations for this project as well.

> Lastly, we do have some plaster issues and hope to be able to address possible leaks in the roof in the near future.

As we seek God in our individual spiritual lives, may we remember what the Church asks of us in our communal worship each week – to outwardly and inwardly praise God through our gifts and best efforts!
