THE PASTOR'S WEEKLY REFLECTION/ REFLEXION SEMANAL DEL PASTOR

On this Feast Day we have the opportunity to gain a Plenary Indulgence by praying an Act of Consecration of the Human Race to the Sacred Heart Jesus. If you are in the state of grace right now, pray it in your heart and recite the consecration prayer. Intend to receive the indulgence for the full remission of the temporal punishment due to your sin, or for a deceased loved one and go to confession in the next 20 days. If you are not in a state of grace, pray anyway, make a spiritual communion and refrain from receiving Holy Communion, may the prayer and fasting be a preparation for an Act of Contrition and the beginning of a firm resolution to refrain from sin and to confess as soon as possible. May the mercy of the Pierced One who comes in glory to transform your kingdom be granted to you in order to assent to His Kingdom.

Act of Consecration

Most sweet Jesus, Redeemer of the human race, look down upon us humbly prostrate before Thy altar. We are Thine, and Thine we wish to be; but to be more surely united with Thee, behold each one of us freely consecrates himself today to Thy most Sacred Heart. Many indeed have never known Thee; many too, despising Thy precepts, have rejected Thee. Have mercy on them all, most merciful Jesus, and draw them to Thy Sacred Heart. Be Thou King, O Lord, not only of the faithful who have never forsaken Thee, but also of the prodigal children who have abandoned Thee; grant that they may quickly return to their Father's house lest they die of wretchedness and hunger. Be Thou King of those who are deceived by erroneous opinions, or whom discord keeps aloof, and call them back to the harbor of truth and unity of faith, so that soon there may be but one flock and one Shepherd. Be Thou King of all those who are still involved in the darkness of idolatry or of Islamism, and refuse not to draw them all into the light and kingdom of God. Turn Thine eyes of mercy towards the children of that race, once Thy chosen people: of old they called down upon themselves the Blood of the Savior; may It now descend upon them, a laver of redemption and of life. Grant, O Lord, to Thy Church assurance of freedom and immunity from harm; give peace and order to all nations, and make the earth resound from pole to pole with one cry: "Praise be to the Divine Heart that wrought our salvation; to It be glory and honor for ever." Amen.

She said "we would pilgrim to the cemetery after Mass..." referring to the tradition of processions from the church to the cemetery on All Souls Day to pray for the Faithful Departed at the graveside. This use of "pilgrim" as a verb is very fitting to describe what we are doing in walking procession as well as our larger journey throughout life, to Heaven. This Sunday, we will process at Sts. John and Patrick, outside the church and/or around the block, with Our Lord in the monstrance. Not only does this give public witness to our faith in the True Presence and the Kingship of Christ, externally, but inwardly, we remember that this world is not our home and we are all pilgrims, walking forward in faith toward Our Lord.
