It is with sadness that we share the news of the passing of Pope Francis on Monday, April 21st.

We encourage the faithful to consider praying regularly for the Holy Father in the coming days, as we await the upcoming election.

Consider offering the following:

Recite one Our Father, one Hail Mary, and one Glory be, for the Holy Father's happy repose.

During this Jubilee of Hope, Make a visit to the Cathedral to offer a time of adoration to gain a plenary indulgence for the Holy Father. During the visit, recite: one Our Father, one Hail Mary, the Creed and ensure that you are in a state of grace. Receive Holy Communion and Confession with the intention of extending the indulgence for the sake of Pope Francis.

Alternatively: You might recite the above prayers and gain the Indulgence by: Spending time with those in need - the sick, prisoners, lonely elderly, the disabled, by "making a pilgrimage to Christ present in them" (Bull of Indiction for the Jubilee).

THE PASTOR'S WEEKLY REFLECTION**"Doubting Thomas Sunday"**

Customarily, the second Sunday after Easter is known by the above title, due to the text of the Gospel. In the East, however, there is a tradition of referring to moment of St. Thomas, *Didymus* (twin), as the "Touching of Thomas," due to the invitation from the Lord to invite him to reach out and *believe*. This *stretch* toward the Person of Christ allows him to exclaim: "My Lord, and my God!"

Here we see his faith come alive that propels him to reach further than any other apostle to spread the Gospel to the known world. He is considered the founder of Christianity and the local Church in India, quite a long reach for a *doubter*.

We all struggle with faith, yet, the Lord invites us to embrace His Divine Mercy this weekend and to allow His grace to heal us and then to share how we have been healed, to provide a testimony to those who might yet believe.

If you are able, please take advantage of the Divine Mercy Novena today at 3:00 PM at St. John's. We'll have two confessors for your convenience to take advantage of the unique graces extended on "Doubting Thomas Sunday," or "Divine Mercy Sunday."

Please be assured of my prayers this week.

REFLEXIÓN SEMANAL DEL PÁRROCO**"Domingo de Tomás el Incrédulo"**

Tradicionalmente, el segundo domingo después de Pascua se conoce con este título, debido al texto del Evangelio. Sin embargo, en Oriente, existe la tradición de referirse al momento de Santo Tomás, Dídimo (gemelo), como el "Toque de Tomás", debido a la invitación del Señor a acercarse y *creer*. Este acercamiento a la Persona de Cristo le permite exclamar: "¡Señor mío y Dios mío!".

Aquí vemos cobrar vida su fe, que lo impulsa a ir más lejos que cualquier otro apóstol para difundir el Evangelio al mundo conocido. Se le considera el fundador del cristianismo y de la Iglesia local en la India, un camino bastante largo para alguien que *duda*.

Todos luchamos con la fe; sin embargo, el Señor nos invita a abrazar su Divina Misericordia este fin de semana y a permitir que su gracia nos sane, para luego compartir cómo hemos sido sanados, para dar testimonio a quienes aún podrían creer.

Si les es posible, aprovechen la Novena a la Divina Misericordia hoy a las 3:00 PM en la iglesia de San Juan. Tendremos dos confesores para su comodidad, para que puedan aprovechar las gracias especiales que se otorgan el Domingo de Tomás el Incrédulo o Domingo de la Divina Misericordia.

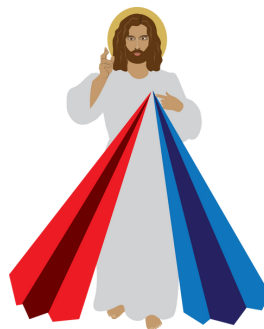
