THE PASTOR'S WEEKLY REFLECTION/ REFLEXIÓN SEMANAL DEL PÁRROCO

The second reading provides a simple reflection on the vision of heaven. What do you envision life to be after death? We're used to thinking: "that's it," but we're also used to thinking, "what's next?" Human nature is conditioned to *anticipation*, and "Let's reset," etc. We know that is true, so that suggests *possibility*. The Lord gives you the framework in your human constitution to "begin again,"... constantly. What a grace that is. So, what are you going to do with it? Will you remain where you are? Or, will you begin again? Praise the Lord for the graces he extends in this Easter Season.

Music at Saint Patrick and Saint John

Each liturgical season of the year has a proper Marian hymn (or, antiphon). The Marian antiphon assigned for the Easter Season is *Regina caeli*,

"O Queen of Heaven, for He whom you did merit to bear has risen, rejoice and be glad, alleluia!"

When we sing the Marian hymn at the end of each sung Mass, we praise Our Lord for rising from the dead and remember the joy of Our Lady when the tomb was found empty.

Marian devotion, as we express today in our various Marian processions throughout the cluster, is a thing is beautiful insofar as it draws us out of ourselves to that which is truly real – the Lord. Our Lady points us to the risen Christ through the dedication of her life to the Lord's will.

As we sing the *Regina caeli*, may we say with Our Lady, "rejoice and glad, He has risen, alleluia!"


