We are a community made up of three welcoming parishes, and we are truly excited to have you join us at Pro-Cathedral of St. Peter, St. Patrick and St. John. Your presence is a blessing, and we look forward to growing together in faith and service under your leadership.

Below is a brief biography to help us all get to know Fr. Joseph a little better:

Rev. Fr. Joseph Christian Indadaño was ordained on December 2, 2013 at the Parish of St. Joseph the Worker – Malinao in the Diocese of Kalibo, Philippines.

He is 39 years old and the youngest of 7 children. His older brother (3rd child), Rev. Fr. Jonnifer Indadaño, is also a priest.

Fr. Joseph has a Licentiate in Canon Law, a Bachelor in Sacred Theology, and a Bachelor of Arts with a Major in Philosophy. He was also a Latin Teacher.

Before being transferred to the Diocese of Richmond, Fr. Joseph held the positions of Chancellor, Director of the Diocesan Commission on Social Communication, Member of the Diocesan College of Consultors, and Member of the Presbyteral Council for the Diocese of Kalibo.

Fr. Joseph was also previously a Member of the Parish Team Ministry of St. John the Baptist Cathedral Parish in Kalibo, Aklan. Most recently, July 1, 2024, Fr. Joseph was appointed Parochial Vicar of Church of the Incarnation in Charlottesville and Our Lady of the Rosary in Crozet.

Fr. Joseph has been appointed Administrator of the Richmond Cluster, Pro-Cathedral of St. Peter Downtown Richmond, St. Patrick Church Hill, and St. John Highland Springs, effective July 1, 2025.

Antes de ser transferido a la Diócesis de Richmond, el Padre Joseph ocupó los cargos de Canciller, Director de la Comisión Diocesana de Comunicación Social, Miembro del Colegio Diocesano de Consultores y Miembro del Consejo Presbiteral de la Diócesis de Kalibo.

También formó parte del Equipo Pastoral de la Parroquia de la Catedral de San Juan Bautista en Kalibo, Aklan. Más recientemente, el 1 de julio de 2024, el Padre Joseph fue nombrado Vicario Parroquial de la Iglesia de la Encarnación en Charlottesville y de Nuestra Señora del Rosario en Crozet.

El Padre Joseph ha sido nombrado Administrador del Clúster de Richmond, que incluye la Pro-Catedral de San Pedro en el centro de Richmond, San Patricio en Church Hill y San Juan en Highland Springs, con efecto a partir del 1 de julio de 2025.
